of a Saviour who would bring peace.

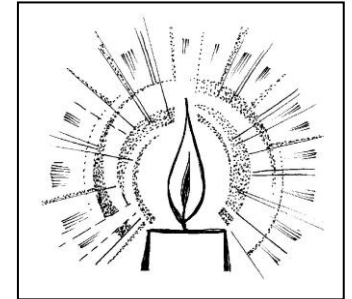
You helped them to spread the joyful message
