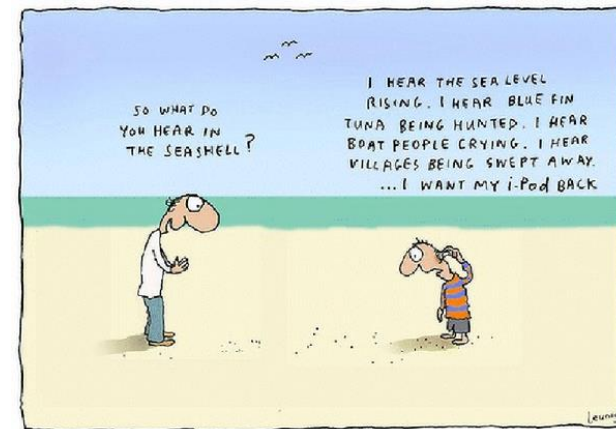
There is a Redeemer,
