Help us, as we prepare to celebrate his birth,

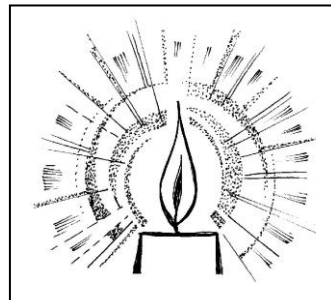
to share with those around us
