2 Corinthians 5: 18

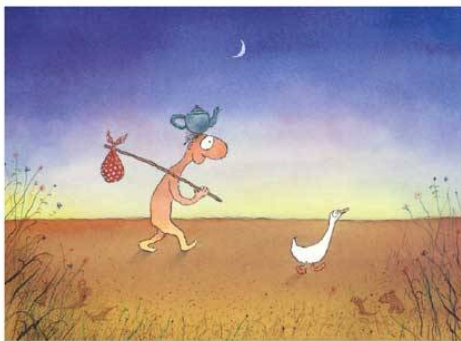
